## CARES Act Reporting

1. An acknowledgement that the school signed and returned the Certification and Agreement and the assurance that the institution used—or intends to use—at least 50 percent of the CARES Act funds received for emergency grants to students.
  - Colorado Christian University submitted the request and Certification for funds on April 14, 2020; and received the award of the funds on April 24, 2020.
2. The total amount of funds a school received—or will receive—from ED.
  - Colorado Christian University received an allocation award in the amount of \$2,267,714.
    - i. \$1,133,857 to be awarded to eligible students per the CARES Act
    - ii. \$1,133,857 to be used for reimbursement for expenses incurred by CCU as a result of COVID-19 disruption for on-campus instruction, housing, etc.
3. The total amount of emergency grants distributed to students as of the posting/submission date.
  - Colorado Christian University is awaiting additional guidance from the U.S. Department of Education before distributing grants.
4. The estimated number of students eligible to participate in the emergency grant program (the number of Title IV-eligible students under Section 484 of the Higher Education Act).
  - 1,084
5. The total number of students who have received emergency grants under the CARES Act.
  - 0 as of May 25, 2020. See statement under Question #3.
6. The method(s) used to determine which students received the emergency grants and how much they received.
  - The eligible student population was determined by identifying all students who had a valid Free Application for Federal Student Aid, and were participating in classes taught on campus.
7. Any instructions, directions, or guidance provided to students concerning the emergency grants.
  - Eligible students were sent an email immediately after disbursement was made to their student account.
