



Master of Science in Psychology

The Master of Science in Psychology degree program is a great match for students who have already earned their bachelor's degree and want to further their ability to help others overcome challenges involving human behavior in a wide variety of career options or to serve as a stepping stone for further graduate studies including a doctoral degree in Psychology (Ph.D.). This 30-credit hour degree program is offered 100% online, with a format and flexibility that can be completed in as little as 15 months of consecutive coursework, even with a full-time job.

- Techniques of Forensic Practice
- Motivational Psychology and Theory

Students acquire a thorough knowledge of the major theories and content areas comprising the foundation of psychology, all taught from a biblical perspective. Upon graduation, students will have an expanded range of job opportunities, including human resources, talent management, behavior analysis, law enforcement/probation officer, social work, victim advocacy, juvenile offender counseling, casework, teaching, curriculum design, educational consulting, and school counseling.
