



Master of Arts in Curriculum and Instruction

The Master of Arts in Curriculum and Instruction (MACI) at Colorado Christian University provides you with the tools to enhance your educational career in teaching, training, administration, and curriculum development. The MACI degree is designed to further your cognitive abilities and relational skills. You will be able to apply a worldview informed by biblical scholarship as you learn to design and deliver curriculum.

You may earn a traditional master's degree in Curriculum and Instruction, or choose one of three options for an emphasis: Biblical Studies, Alternative Licensing, or Culturally and Linguistically Diverse Education. The Alternative Licensing program is authorized by the Colorado Department of Education.

A total of 36 credit hours are required for the Master of Arts in Curriculum and Instruction degree. (You complete 18 credits from the professional core and the remaining credits will reflect whether or not you pursue an emphasis.)
