## ASSOCIATE OF ARTS IN GENERAL STUDIES

The Associate of Arts in General Studies degree combines general education and elective courses, which will prepare you to earn a bachelor's degree — creating a solid foundation for career opportunities and advancement. Our faculty members make scholarship and experience come alive in the classroom, applying a wealth of academic and professional experience, and affording you the advantages of real-life perspectives while you learn.

In this program, you'll gain a broad foundation of knowledge through General Studies courses that cover every aspect of general education, including communications, humanities, history, behavioral and social sciences, biblical studies, mathematics, natural science, and computer science. This program could be your first step toward completing a bachelor's degree.



## SAVE TIME AND MONEY BY TRANSFERRING CREDITS.

### PRIOR LEARNING CREDIT

Save time and money by earning college credit for your life experience. There are two ways of doing so: credit by portfolio and credit by exam. Build a portfolio of your post-high school personal and professional learning experiences. Or take advantage of low-cost CLEP, DSST, and UExcel testing options to test out of electives and many general education requirements.

**Associate Degree: up to 45 credits**

**Bachelor's Degree: up to 75 credits**

### TRANSFER CREDIT FROM ANOTHER COLLEGE

If you started a degree at another regionally or nationally accredited college or university, you may be able to transfer credits toward your CCU degree. You can also earn credit through CCU's partnership with Straighterline.

**Associate Degree: up to 45 credits**

**Bachelor's Degree: up to 90 credits**

Accepted transfer credits vary by degree program. Check with your CCU enrollment counselor about transfer credit options for master's degree programs.

Flexibility is the calling card for online degree programs — and a main reason why the College of Adult and Graduate Studies offers online education through CCU Online.

Whether you routinely travel for work, have an irregular schedule, or keep track of multiple schedules in your family, online courses are flexible enough to work with you. As long as you have internet access, you will be able to log into your courses; you can even complete some assignments on your smartphone.

### **EARN THE SAME DEGREE.**

At CCU, "online" refers only to the format of the courses. You will earn a quality degree whether you take courses in a classroom, or online.

When you receive your diploma from us, there will be no indication that the program was delivered online or on campus — because you will be prepared to succeed in your field in the same way that we prepare students who take courses in the classroom.

### **PREPARE FOR THE FUTURE.**

Education is meant to prepare you to succeed both in the workplace and in life. Right now, over half of the U.S. workforce already has jobs that are compatible with remote work.\*\*

There are unique abilities and skills needed to be able to work effectively in a remote job position, which is why it's important for you to be prepared with those skills.

Students who participate in online learning will be challenged to demonstrate superior time management and self-motivation; advanced online collaboration skills and computer literacy; and discipline and perseverance — all qualities necessary to work effectively in a virtual role.

### **ENJOY COMMUNITY, ONLINE.**

Our students learn best in community, that's why we offer a cohort model of learning for adult students. The cohort system groups you with other students who are in the same degree or certificate program, and you stay together in your courses until you graduate.
