The Master of Business Administration programs at Colorado Christian University focus on management and leadership. You will develop critical thinking, decision-making, and people management skills. Many different styles of leadership are explored including, transactional, transformational, authentic, and “servant leadership” from a biblical perspective, incorporating the eternal wisdom and love of Jesus Christ in the way you lead others. You will actively engage in endeavors that have a sustainable impact in public policy and social change, encouraging you to apply your learning experience in real time.

CCU's MBA programs are ideal for adults who aspire toward senior management positions, such as CEO or COO, or want to be successful business owners or ministry leaders. The principles and skills you'll acquire will apply to you in both for-profit and nonprofit fields, as well as the military and law enforcement — virtually any organizational setting.

CCU's MBA program offers five emphases: Leadership, Advanced Accounting, Healthcare Administration, Project Management, and Enterprise Agility.

Students can use credit by portfolio to substitute up to nine (9) credits (three courses) or add a custom emphasis.

**Within your MBA degree, you are required to choose an emphasis:
Leadership, Advanced Accounting, Enterprise Agility, Healthcare Administration, Project Management.**

LEADERSHIP EMPHASIS

The MBA with an emphasis in Leadership provides a more in-depth study of leadership theory and ethical practice. Students also develop knowledge and skills in financial responsibility and control, markets and promotional strategy, problem-solving and decision-making, human resource management, international business, and research skills.

ADVANCED ACCOUNTING EMPHASIS

The MBA with an emphasis in Advanced Accounting is designed for students who plan to pursue their Certified Public Accounting (CPA) credential, as it provides for the educational requirements in the Colorado State Board of Accountancy. Students must possess an undergraduate degree in accounting (or equivalent) to select this emphasis.

ENTERPRISE AGILITY

CCU's MBA with an emphasis in Enterprise Agility is designed to train students in all major aspects of managing high-level projects, including strategic management, organizational leadership, and project-based teamwork utilizing agile concepts. Incorporating agile concepts provides organizational leaders with the ability to move more quickly and respond to rapid, on-demand changes in a competitive and dynamic environment.

HEALTHCARE ADMINISTRATION EMPHASIS

The MBA with an emphasis in Healthcare Administration focuses on practical application and unique requirements of the healthcare field, preparing leaders to be effective in many industry responsibility areas.

PROJECT MANAGEMENT EMPHASIS

The MBA with an emphasis in Project Management builds the knowledge, skills, and processes necessary to attain organizational objectives related to strategic management, project-based teamwork, risk reduction, and risk management. Students interested in obtaining a Project Management Professional (PMP®) certification may apply 42 professional development units (PDUs) for each of the following courses: Fundamentals of Project Management for Business (MGT 520), Business Project Planning, Scheduling, and Controlling (MGT 560); and Strategic Leadership of Project Management in Business (MGT 610).*

** The Bachelor's degree in Organizational Management in Project Management includes some graduate-level courses that may be transferred to the MBA – Project Management program.*
