# BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

The Master of Business Administration programs at Colorado Christian University focus on management and leadership. You will develop critical thinking, decision-making, and people management skills. You'll explore the concept of servant leadership and consider how to incorporate the eternal wisdom and love of Jesus Christ in the way you lead and manage others in the business environment.

CCU's MBA programs are ideal for adults who aspire toward senior management positions, such as CEO or COO, or want to be successful business owners or ministry leaders. The principles and skills you'll acquire will apply to you in both for-profit and nonprofit fields, as well as the military and law enforcement — virtually any organizational setting.

CCU's MBA program offers four emphases: Leadership, Advanced Accounting, Healthcare Administration, and Project Management.

Students can use credit by portfolio to substitute up to nine (9) credits (three courses) or add a custom emphasis.

**Within your MBA degree, you are required to choose an emphasis:  
Leadership, Advanced Accounting, Healthcare Administration, or Project Management.**

## **LEADERSHIP EMPHASIS**

The MBA with an emphasis in Leadership provides a more in-depth study of leadership theory and ethical practice. Students also develop knowledge and skills in financial responsibility and control, markets and promotional strategy, problem-solving and decision-making, human resource management, international business, and research skills.

## **ADVANCED ACCOUNTING EMPHASIS**

The MBA with an emphasis in Advanced Accounting is designed for students who plan to pursue their Certified Public Accounting (CPA) credential, as it provides for the educational requirements in the Colorado State Board of Accountancy. Students must possess an undergraduate degree in accounting (or equivalent) to take this emphasis.

## **HEALTHCARE ADMINISTRATION EMPHASIS**

The MBA with an emphasis in Healthcare Administration focuses on practical application and unique requirements of the healthcare field, preparing leaders to be effective across a multiple of industry responsibility areas.

## **PROJECT MANAGEMENT EMPHASIS**

The MBA with an emphasis in Project Management builds the knowledge, skills, and processes necessary to attain organizational objectives related to strategic management, project-based teamwork, risk reduction, and risk management. Students interested in obtaining a PMI Project Management Professional (PMP)<sup>®</sup> certification may apply 42 professional development units (PDUs) for each of the following courses: Fundamentals of Project Management for Business (MGT 520), Business Project Planning, Scheduling, and Controlling (MGT 560); and Strategic Leadership of Project Management in Business (MGT 610).\*

*\* The Bachelor's degree in Organizational Management in Project Management includes some graduate-level courses that may be transferred to the MBA – Project Management program.*
