The principles and skills you'll acquire will apply to you in both for-profit and nonprofit fields, as well as the military and law enforcement — virtually any organizational setting.

CCU's MBA program offers six emphases: Leadership, Advanced Accounting, Healthcare Administration, Project Management, Cyber Security, and Enterprise Agility.
