## Young Christian Conservatives Leadership Conference

### Lifestyle Agreement

While attending the Young Conservatives Leadership Conference, students are expected to uphold certain standards in line with Colorado Christian University expectations. Attendees are expected to be aware of and follow the guidelines and standards provided below, to act in consideration of others, and to exercise personal restraint.

◆ **Alcohol**— Colorado Christian University is a dry campus which means alcohol is not permitted in CCU facilities or on CCU grounds or at CCU activities and events. The use of alcohol, even by of-age students, while attending the YCCLC is strictly prohibited.

◆ **Tobacco**—Colorado Christian University is a tobacco-free campus. Smoking is prohibited in all areas of campus (inside and outside) Guests and students are not permitted to have tobacco products or other similar products (e-cigarettes, vapor cigarettes, hookah or other smoking devices) in the apartments or any other University buildings or grounds.

◆ **Drugs**—Students and guests are expected to abstain from the use of illicit or non-medical drugs, narcotics, and other controlled substances. This includes the use of marijuana.

◆ **Sexual Relationships**—Grounded in Christ-centered traditions and principles, CCU's community values define sexual intercourse and other forms of intensely interpersonal sexual activity as the unique expression of the covenanted love within a heterosexual marriage. Sexual activity as a YCCLC participant is prohibited on and off campus. Any inappropriate behavior by a fellow student, student leader or staff member may be reported to Jim McCormick, Vice President for Student Development or Sharon Felker, Dean of Students.

◆ **Guests**—Guests of YCCLC participants must be approved by Jim McCormick and are not allowed to spend the night on campus.

◆ **Visitation**—Opposite gender students may visit each other's apartment beginning at 10:00 a.m. and ending at 10:00 p.m. Visitation by opposite gender students may only occur in the public areas of the apartments (living room, kitchen). Opposite gender students may not be in the bedrooms.

◆ **Curfew**—All YCCLC participants must be in their own apartment by 12:00 a.m. (midnight) each day.

◆ **Leaving the CCU campus**—YCCLC participants may not leave the CCU campus except for the off campus excursions taken by all students. An exception to this rule must be approved by Jim McCormick.

◆**Conference Sessions**—YCCLC participants will attend all conference sessions and excursions with his/her group. Students are expected to be on time and ready to participate.

◆**Unauthorized Presence**—YCCLC participants will refrain from entering construction areas. YCCLC participants must stay out of the pond and any designated restricted areas.

◆**Housing rules**—No weapons (knives, guns, etc), candles or pets are allowed. Do not remove screens from the windows or moving furniture out of the apartments. Quiet hours begin at 10:00 p.m. Quiet hours includes the sand volleyball courts. All activity on the sand volleyball courts must cease at 10:00 p.m.

◆ **General Inappropriate Behavior or Disorderly Conduct**—Behavior that is deemed to be inappropriate for the Christian nature of the University and the conference. This can include, but is not limited to indecent exposure disruption to the housing operations or conference sessions, damage to University facilities and/or grounds and other behavior deemed to be inappropriate or disruptive by the CCU Vice President for Student Life or his designee.
