If you are entering CCU in the spring semester (January start date), please follow the spring dates.

Things to do soon after being admitted:

- Complete your FAFSA (if not already done)
- Apply for your Digital Service Account (DSA)
- View your financial aid package
- Pay your tuition deposit
- Schedule a music audition

Things to do after paying your tuition deposit:

- Submit your housing deposit and application or waiver
- Select your meal plan
- Set up your CCU Digital Service Account
- Register for classes for the upcoming semester
- Register for Weekend of Welcome (fall)
- Read about New Student Retreat (fall)
- Register for Winter Welcome (spring)

Things to do at least every other day:

- Check your CCU email

Things to do before July 1 (fall) / December 1 (spring):

- If applicable, request ADA accommodations from the Life Directions Center

Things to do before August 1 (fall) / January 1 (spring):

- Make final financial arrangements 8/1 (fall); 12/15 (spring)
- Submit your final high school transcripts and scores from CLEP, AP, and IB
- Submit the Lifestyle Covenant
- Submit your photo for your official student ID
- Submit all required health information
- Register your vehicle and your bicycle
- Check out what you need for textbooks
- Look at available student jobs
- Check out what CCU has to offer for your computer
- View technology requirements
- Peruse the "What to Bring" list
- Take note of important dates
- Sign the release form for WOW Service Day (fall)
