

Frequently Asked Questions

1. *How can I be invited to Scholarship Recognition Weekend?*

You must be accepted to Colorado Christian University for the Fall 2019 or Spring 2020 terms and be a scholarship recipient. To apply and be accepted to CCU in time for this event, contact the Office of Undergraduate Admissions at 303.963.3200.

2. *Do I need to pay my housing and tuition deposit in order to attend SRW and register for classes and housing?*

Yes. Your tuition deposit of \$150.00 and your housing deposit (if applicable) of \$100.00 must be paid in order to register for classes and housing at SRW. You can pay your deposit by visiting ccu.edu/deposit.

3. *Can my parents attend SRW with me?*

Yes! We have a complete program for both students and parents beginning on Friday, April 26 at 9:30 a.m. and concluding on Saturday, April 27 at 12:00 p.m.

4. *Are parents required to attend?*

No. Scholarship recipients are welcome to attend this event individually. However, we do have a full program for parents. All programs scheduled for parents are optional, so parents are welcome to attend as much or as little of the event as they would like.

5. *Can I stay on campus for SRW?*

Yes. Students who are registered for SRW will be hosted on campus the evening of Friday, April 26 with a CCU Student Host. Please note that overnight accommodations on campus are available for one night only.

6. *Where should my parents stay?*

Overnight accommodations on campus are only available for the student registered for SRW. Parents and other guests can find accommodations near campus. For a list of local hotels and accommodations, please visit ccu.edu/about/hotels.

7. *I'm staying overnight on campus, what should I bring?*

Please bring a sleeping bag and pillow. You will be hosted in a student apartment with a CCU Student Host.

8. *What attire is required for the Scholarship Celebration on Friday evening?*

Business casual attire is appropriate for the Friday evening celebration.

9. *My parents want to only attend the celebration, what time will it be held and where?*

The Scholarship Celebration and Evening of Worship will be held in our CCU Event Center beginning at 7:30 p.m. Friday evening, April 26.

10. *Are meals provided for the event?*

Yes. All meals during Scholarship Recognition Weekend are provided to registered scholarship recipients and parents. Please provide the number of guests you are bringing for each meal on your registration form.

11. Is there a charge for this event?

No. The Scholarship Recognition Weekend events and meals are all offered at no cost and are completely free for scholarship recipients and parents.

12. I am not planning to live on campus, what should I do?

Freshmen students are required to live on campus, however, certain exceptions apply. Please contact your [Enrollment Counselor](#) at the Office of Admissions at 303.963.3200.

13. Am I required to attend both Friday, April 26 and Saturday, April 27 of this event?

14. Does CCU provide transportation to and/or from Denver International Airport (DIA)?

CCU is pleased to provide complimentary airport transportation for students traveling unaccompanied at the scheduled pickup and drop off times only. Prior to booking your flight, contact your Enrollment Counselor for shuttle reservations. CCU is approximately 45 minutes from DIA so please plan your arrival and departure times carefully to align with our program start and end times.

15. When should I schedule my departure from DIA on Saturday, April 27?

Our Scholarship Recognition Weekend program will close at 12:00 p.m. on Saturday, April 27. Our complimentary shuttle is only available for students traveling alone and will depart campus at 1:00 p.m. for DIA. Please allow a minimum of 45 minutes for transportation from campus to DIA and plan your departing flight accordingly to allow for arrival, check-in and security.
